On October 14, 1981, Anna Harry Coffey and Lovoice Coffey Cozad (appellants), through counsel, Amos E. Black III, Esq., of Anadarko, Oklahoma, filed a notice of appeal from an August 21, 1981, order on rehearing issued by Administrative Law Judge Sam E. Taylor. The order determined the distribution of the proceeds of a condemnation action against the Indian trust allotments involved in this estate.

On October 20, 1981, the Board received a telegram from appellants, submitted pro sese, requesting the Board to disregard the notice of appeal filed on their behalf. On November 2, 1981, counsel for appellants filed a document entitled notice of removal of appeal, which also requested that the appeal be dismissed. Accordingly, the case is docketed under the above docket number and is dismissed without prejudice.
