By order dated July 12, 1982, the United States District Court for the District of Arizona granted appellant's motion to compel arbitration in San Tan Ranches v. United States of America, No. CIV 80-359 PHX VAC. This court case involves the same issue as IBIA 81-15-A. The court's decision reverses the Board's orders of November 18, 1981, and February 18, 1982, referring the case for an evidentiary hearing over appellant's arguments that arbitration should be required.

Because of this ruling, further proceedings in IBIA 81-15-A before Administrative Law Judge Michael L. Morehouse are stayed and the case is recalled from the Hearings Division and dismissed without prejudice.
