On June 13, 1983, the Board of Indian Appeals received a letter from Delores Davis, one of the appellants in the above case. The letter apparently seeks reconsideration of the Board's decision, published at 11 IBIA 163 (1983).

The Board's regulations in 43 CFR 4.315(a) provide that a petition for reconsideration must be filed within 30 days from receipt of the decision involved. The return receipt card signed by Delores Davis indicates that she received the decision on April 19, 1983. Although under 43 CFR 4.310(d), the Board may extend the time for filing a petition for reconsideration, a motion for an extension of time must be received within the time originally allowed for filing the petition.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this petition for reconsideration must be denied as untimely.
