On June 26, 1985, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a petition for reconsideration from appellant Patricia Ann Schoolcraft Patencio. Appellant seeks reconsideration of the Board's decision in Patencio v. Sacramento Area Director, 13 IBIA 150 (1985).
