On June 26, 1986, the Board of Indian Appeals received a motion from the Tuba City High School Board, Inc. (appellant) requesting it to assume jurisdiction over an appeal filed with the Deputy Assistant Secretary--Indian Affairs (Operations) pursuant to 25 CFR Part 2. Appellant sought review of a February 18, 1986, decision of the Navajo Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning a request to adjust the fiscal year 1986 funding for the operation of the Tuba City High School under contract No. N00 C 1420 9930.

By order dated July 2, 1986, the Board made a preliminary determination that it had jurisdiction over the matter and requested the record. The record was received on August 1, 1986.

On October 3, 1986, the Board received a motion from appellant seeking to withdraw its appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, and at the request of appellant, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
