On July 21, 1986, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received an appeal from Rosemary Castro (appellant). Appellant sought review by the Board of an appeal filed with the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) under 25 CFR Part 2. The appeal concerned the alleged termination of appellant's general assistance benefits by the Northern Cheyenne Tribe, which operates the BIA social services program on the Northern Cheyenne Reservation pursuant to a contract under the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, Pub. L. 93-638. By order dated July 24, 1986, the Board made a preliminary determination that it had jurisdiction over the matter.

No briefs were filed in the appeal. Instead, a joint stipulation for dismissal was received on November 24, 1986.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
