The Board of Indian Appeals received this appeal on October 19, 1987, by transfer from the Deputy to the Assistant Secretary--Indian Affairs (Trust and Economic Development). Appellant Menominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin sought review of a November 6, 1986, letter from the Area Director, Minneapolis Area Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning procedures for taking land in trust for appellant. The appeal was docketed on October 19, 1987.

On December 22, 1987, the Board received a petition from appellant seeking to withdraw its appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, and at the request of appellant, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
