On January 5, 1990, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a notice of appeal from Clara Nomee, Secretary, Crow Tribe (appellant). Appellant sought review of a December 28, 1989, decision of the Billings Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning the release of certain Crow tribal funds to Richard Real Bird, Chairman, Crow Tribe.

The case is hereby assigned the above case name and docket number, which should be cited in all future correspondence or inquiries.

On January 19, 1990, the Board received a motion to dismiss this appeal from appellant. Appellant states that the appeal has been resolved through the issuance on January 10, 1990, of a decision on reconsideration by the Crow Tribal Court in Real Bird v. Nomee, Civ. No. 89-296, and Old Elk v. Nomee, Civ. No. 89-200.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal from the December 28, 1989, decision of the Billings Area Director is dismissed.
