This is an appeal from a May 3, 1989, decision of the Billings Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, holding that appellant owed \$40,036.22 in oil and gas rental payments for Blackfeet tribal leases 6159-6166, 6169-6172, and 6177-6182 for the lease year ending October 22, 1987.

By order of July 27, 1989, the Board stayed proceedings after appellant stated that it and the Blackfeet Tribe were in the process of negotiating a joint venture agreement which would settle the appeal.

On December 4, 1990, the Board received notice from appellant that the joint venture agreement was approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs on November 2, 1990, and provides, inter alia, for appellant to withdraw this appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal is dismissed.
