This is an appeal from a March 13, 1990, decision of the Muskogee Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, finding that Oil and Gas Lease 602-4893 (67032), Lizzie Postoak, Seminole NE, had expired by its own terms because of failure to produce oil and/or gas in paying quantities. Proceedings have been stayed since August 2, 1990, at the request of the parties, in order to allow them to attempt settlement.

On February 13, 1991, the Board received a motion to dismiss this appeal from appellee. Appellee states that the parties have reached settlement and encloses a copy of the settlement agreement.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, the settlement agreement is approved and this appeal is dismissed.
