Appellant Darcille Freeman Harjo sought review of a November 16, 1990, decision issued by the Muskogee Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, denying her application to remove restrictions on certain lands she owned in Wagoner County, Oklahoma, in order to exchange that property for a house in the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

On March 14, 1991, the Board of Indian Appeals received an application from appellant, requesting that her appeal be dismissed.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, and appellant's request, this appeal from the Muskogee Area Director's November 16, 1990, decision is dismissed.
