Appellant Kickapoo Tribe of Oklahoma attempted to appeal a March 13, 1991, decision of the Anadarko Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs. The Area Director denied appellant's request to amend or waive provisions of general counsel contract no. B00C14208302-823, in order to approve the hiring of the law firm of Hobbs, Straus, Dean & Wilder as additional tribal counsel, and to use tribal funds to pay that law firm accrued fees and costs.

The appeal has been withdrawn by counsel for appellant.

Therefore, pursuant, to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal from the March 13, 1991, decision of the Anadarko Area Director is dismissed.
