This is an appeal from a January 7, 1993, decision of the Anadarko Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, rejecting an application for an Indian Business Development Program (IBDP) grant. On March 12, 1993, the Board issued a notice of docketing and order of limited remand.

The Area Director now requests that this matter be fully remanded to him in order to allow him to take certain additional factors into consideration and issue a new decision.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, the Area Director's January 7, 1993, decision is vacated, and this matter is remanded to him for further consideration.
