This is an appeal from a December 16, 1991, decision of the Minneapolis Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, and/or a February 12, 1992, decision of the Acting Director, Office of Administration, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning Linda Dorvinen's eligibility for retention of Federal personnel benefits upon acceptance of a position with the Leech Lake Reservation Tribal Council. Proceedings in this matter have been stayed since July 2, 1992, in order to allow the parties to attempt settlement.

On July 7, 1993, the Board received a settlement agreement signed by all the parties. The agreement concludes: "The parties hereby stipulate to a dismissal with prejudice of this appeal upon ratification of this Settlement Agreement by the Interior Board of Indian Appeals."

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, the parties' settlement agreement is approved, and this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
