Appellant Govern Stetson, Williams & West, P.C., sought review of an August 23, 1989, decision of the Billings Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, disapproving a proposed amendment to a special counsel attorney contract between appellant and the Crow Tribe. This matter has been stayed since January 4, 1990, while the parties pursued settlement.

On January 11, 1996, the Board received a letter from appellant stating that the matter had been settled, and requesting dismissal.

Pursuant to the agreement of the parties and the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal is dismissed.
