Appellant Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua & Siuslaw Indians sought review of two decisions issued by the Portland Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs. The first decision was issued on February 6, 1995, and denied appellant's appeal from a Finding of No Significant Impact in relation to a business lease between the Coquille Indian Tribe (Tribe) and the Coquille Economic Development Corporation (CEDCO) (Docket No. IBIA 95-98-A). The second decision was issued on February 9, 1995, and approved a business lease between the Tribe and CEDCO (Docket No. IBIA 95-90-A).

On February 21, 1996, the Board received a letter from appellant withdrawing the two appeals.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, and appellant's withdrawal of its appeals, these appeals are dismissed with prejudice.
