Appellant Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association, Inc., sought review of a June 20, 1996, decision issued by the Juneau Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs. The decision denied appellant's claim for reimbursement of attorney fees allegedly incurred in connection with implementation of the Aleutian and Pribilof Islands Restitution Act of 1988, P.L. 100-383, 102 Stat. 911.

On December 31, 1996, appellant notified the Board that the matter has been resolved between the parties.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, and the agreement reached between the parties, this appeal from the Juneau Area Director's June 20, 1996, decision is docketed and dismissed.
