This is an appeal from a November 7, 1995, decision of the Navajo Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning the status of 16 leases or subleases of retail business sites on the Navajo Reservation.

Proceedings have been stayed since March 12, 1996, while the parties have engaged in settlement negotiations.

On February 23, 1998, the Board received a stipulated motion to dismiss this appeal. The motion, filed jointly by Appellant, the Area Director, and the Navajo Nation, states that "the issues raised herein have been fully resolved and compromised to the satisfaction of all concerned."

Therefore, at the request of the parties, and pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
