On December 29, 1997, the Board of Indian Appeals dismissed this appeal for lack of jurisdiction. 31 IBIA 308. Subsequently, the Board received another filing from Pounds. The Board treated the filing as a petition for reconsideration and denied it on February 9, 1998. 32 IBIA 60.

The Board has received yet another filing from Pounds, who now appears to be asking the Board to reconsider its February 9, 1998, order.

Under 43 C.F.R. § 4.315(b), a party may file only one petition for reconsideration.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this petition for reconsideration is denied. Appellant is advised that, to the extent she ever had any right to seek review from the Board, that right has now been exhausted. Any further review must be sought in Federal district court.
