This is an appeal from a December 28, 1995, decision of the Navajo Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, finding Appellant in trespass on Navajo tribal land and requiring the removal of structures and improvements.

Proceedings have been stayed since September 16, 1996, while the parties have engaged in settlement negotiations.

On March 30, 1998, the Board received Appellant's Notice of Withdrawal of Appeal.

Therefore, at the request of Appellant, and pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
