Appellant Rio Arriba Board of County Commissioners sought review of a January 7, 1999, decision issued by the Acting Albuquerque Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning taking approximately 5,679.08 acres of land into trust for the Jicarilla Apache Tribe. On March 8, 1999, the Board received a letter from Appellant withdrawing its appeal.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, and Appellant's withdrawal of its appeal, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
