On July 16, 1999, the Board of Indian Appeals received a notice of appeal from the Santa Fe Indian School, Inc. Appellant seeks review of a June 16, 1999, decision of the Acting Director, Office of Indian Education Programs (OIEP), concerning a request for funding under 25 U.S.C. § 2007(d).

The Acting Director advised Appellant that its appeal should be filed with the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs under 25 C.F.R. Part 2. Under 25 C.F.R. Part 2, decisions of the Director, OIEP, are appealable to the Assistant Secretary rather than this Board. 25 C.F.R. §§ 2.4(c); 2.20(g).

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is docketed, dismissed, and transferred to the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs.
