This is an appeal from a decision of the Director, Office of Economic Development, Bureau of Indian Affairs, which denied a claim for loss on the guaranty of a loan to Tricom Computers.

On October 22, 1999, the Board received a request from Appellant that this appeal be dismissed with prejudice.
