This is an appeal from a May 14, 1997, decision of the Contracting Officer, Billings Area Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning disallowed costs under an Indian Self-Determination Act contract.

Proceedings were stayed on June 25, 1997, to permit Appellant to appeal to the Board of Contract Appeals. Appellant did so. Its appeal was docketed by the Board of Contract Appeals as Docket No. IBCA 3800-97.

On November 3, 1999, this Board received from the Board of Contract Appeals a copy of that Board's order dismissing as settled Docket Nos. IBCA 3800-97 and 4035-1999, together with a copy of the parties' settlement agreement.

It appeared likely that the parties' settlement agreement in the Contracts Board appeals had resolved the issues in this appeal as well. However, Appellant was given an opportunity to show why this appeal should not be dismissed. Appellant's response was due on or before December 10, 1999. No response has been received.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is docketed but is dismissed as having been resolved by the parties' settlement of the appeals in Docket Nos. IBCA 3800-97 and 4035-1999.
