The Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians sought review of a March 22, 2000, decision issued by the Great Plains Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs. The decision disapproved an amendment to the Tribe's Constitution.

The Board has received a joint motion from the parties to remand this matter to the Regional Director for further consideration. The motion is granted.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Regional Director's March 22, 2000, decision is vacated and this matter is remanded to her for further consideration.
