Appellant Bee Forest Products sought review of a May 19, 2000, decision issued by the Midwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning the assessment of damages for timber trespass on the Jesse Stacy Allotment, W $\frac{1}{2}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , sec. 16, T. 26 N., R. 2 W., Clark County, Wisconsin. The allotment is located on the reservation of the Ho-Chunk Nation. In an earlier appeal concerning this trespass, the Board vacated the BIA decision and remanded the matter for further consideration. 34 IBIA 228 (2000).

On September 18, 2000, the Board received a motion to dismiss this proceeding from Appellant. Appellant stated that the parties had entered into a settlement agreement.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed.
