On February 20, 2001, the Board of Indian Appeals received a document from Ducks Unlimited, Inc., which appeared to be a notice of appeal from a December 22, 2000, decision of the Pacific Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to take 321 acres in Sonoma County, California, into trust for the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians of the Hopland Rancheria.

The document did not show that it had been served on the interested parties. The Board therefore ordered Ducks Unlimited to serve the parties.

On February 29, 2001, the Board received a letter from Ducks Unlimited, stating that it did not intend to file a notice of appeal. In light of that clarifying statement, and pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is docketed and dismissed.
