Appellant Governor, State of Wisconsin, sought review of a June 3, 2002, decision of the Midwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning taking approximately 278 acres of land located in Shawano County, Wisconsin, into trust for the Stockbridge-Munsee Indian Community. On December 9, 2003, the Board of Indian Appeals received a filing from Appellant withdrawing his appeal.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice in accordance with Appellant's request.
