Appellant Pechanga Band of Luiseño Mission Indians (Tribe) sought review of an April 26, 2002, decision of the Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs disapproving the Pechanga Gaming Revenue Allocation Act of 1996, which the Tribe had submitted for review under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. §§ 2701 - 2721, and 25 C.F.R. Part 290, Tribal Revenue Allocations Plans. This appeal has been stayed while the parties discussed settlement. On April 1, 2004, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a motion from Appellant for dismissal of its appeal, stating that the dispute has been settled between the parties.

Appellant's motion is granted. The Board appreciates the parties' successful efforts to settle this matter.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed on the basis of a settlement reached between the parties.
