Appellants Michelle L. White Wolf and Sullivan White Wolf, Jr., filed an appeal directed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board), concerning grazing rental charges for 2000 and 2001 on the Cheyenne River Reservation. The notice of appeal was transmitted to the Board by the Office of the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs, to whom it was mailed. For the reason below, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) dismisses this appeal.

In a December 12, 2003, order seeking clarification of the appeal, the Board gave Appellants until January 16, 2004, to provide the Board with a copy of the decision from which they are appealing, with a concise statement of the basis for their appeal. The Board advised them that, "If Appellants do not respond to this order, this appeal will be dismissed for failure to prosecute." (Emphasis omitted).

The Board has received no response from Appellants.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed for failure to prosecute.
