The Shoshone-Paiute Tribes of the Duck Valley Reservation sought review of an October 20, 2000, decision of the Western Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning the finality of a report issued in June, 1998, entitled "Evaluation of Assessable Acreage - Duck Valley Irrigation Project, Idaho and Nevada." Proceedings before the Board have been stayed since June 2001, while the parties negotiated a settlement.

On July 15, 2004, the Board received a joint Stipulation and Request for Dismissal with Prejudice, based on a final settlement agreement entered into by the parties. The parties represented that all conditions and actions required of the parties pursuant to the settlement agreement have been completed and satisfied and requested that the appeal be dismissed.

The parties' request to dismiss this appeal is granted. The Board appreciates the parties' successful efforts to settle this matter.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed on the basis of a settlement reached between the parties.
