Appellants Donnamarie Potts, Frank Vega, and Renee Selvey appealed from a May 6, 2002, decision of the Acting Pacific Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director), concerning the identity of those individuals eligible to reorganize the Buena Vista Rancheria of Me-Wuk Indians of California. This case has been stayed, pending settlement negotiations among the parties.

On December 30, 2004, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a joint motion from Appellants, the Regional Director, and interested party Rhonda L. Morningstar Pope, to dismiss this appeal with prejudice. The motion states that the parties have entered into a settlement agreement resolving all issues pending before the Board.

The Board grants the motion to dismiss.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal, based on a settlement reached among the parties.
