Appellants El Paso Natural Gas Company (EPNG) and El Paso Field Services Company (EPFS) appealed a September 15, 2004, decision of the Acting Navajo Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director), in which the Regional Director declined to approve or otherwise process and record certain assignments from EPNG to EPFS of rights-of-way or easements across Indian lands. ^{1/}

On January 14, 2005, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a motion from Appellants to dismiss this appeal without prejudice.

The Board grants the motion.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal without prejudice.
