Appellant James Quisquis appealed from a September 1, 2005 decision of the Pacific Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, declining to recognize the validity of a General Council meeting of the San Pasqual Band of Mission Indians (Band) held on April 10, 2005, at which a resolution concerning enrollment issues, Resolution No. SP-041005-01, purportedly was adopted. The Board docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.

On October 14, 2005, after receiving the notice of appeal, the Board ordered Appellant, who apparently is a member of the Band, to show that he has standing to bring this appeal, and also to serve his notice of appeal on the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs, as required by 43 C.F.R. § 4.332(a). The Board advised Appellant that failure to respond to the order could result in summary dismissal of the appeal without further notice. Appellant's certificate of service was due by November 7, 2005, and his brief on standing was due November 14, 2005.

The Board has received no response from Appellant.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.
