On February 26, 2007, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) dismissed as untimely an appeal filed by Deborah J. Derickson (Appellant) in the Estate of Doris June Derickson. 44 IBIA 131 (2007). On March 19, 2007, the Board received a letter from Appellant in which she re-argues the merits of her original appeal. The Board treats Appellant's letter as a petition for reconsideration from its dismissal order pursuant to 43 C.F.R. § 4.315.

Reconsideration of a decision of the Board will be granted only in extraordinary circumstances. 43 C.F.R. § 4.315; Jacobs v. Great Plains Regional Director, 43 IBIA 272 (2006). The Board dismissed Appellant's appeal for lack of jurisdiction because it was untimely. In her petition for reconsideration, Appellant does not contend that the Board erred in finding that her appeal was untimely. Appellant has failed to show extraordinary circumstances warranting reconsideration.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board denies reconsideration of 44 IBIA 131.
