Appellant Marie Black Lance sought review of an Order Denying Rehearing entered on February 1, 2008, by Indian Probate Judge (IPJ) Michael Stancampiano in the estate of Harry Joseph Blue Thunder, Sr., deceased Rosebud Sioux Indian, Probate No. P000031340IP. The Board of Indian Appeals (Board) docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.

The Board received Appellant's notice of appeal on April 11, 2008. On April 23, 2008, the Board ordered Appellant to show cause why her appeal should not be dismissed as untimely. Additionally, the Board ordered Appellant to send a copy of her notice of appeal to all interested parties and to file a statement with the Board that she had done so. The Board advised Appellant that failure to comply with the order could result in dismissal of her appeal without further notice.

Appellant's response to the Board's order was due on or before May 14, 2008. The Board has received no communication from Appellant.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.
