Curtis Vavra appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a March 28, 2008, decision of the Acting Great Plains Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director), upholding the Winnebago Agency Superintendent's decision to cancel his Conservation Reserve Program lease (101276-01-11), on a parcel of land known as the James Milton Allotment 276-O,¹ and to collect liquidated damages and the cost of reseeded. The appeal was stayed to allow for settlement negotiations.

On March 23, 2009, the Board received a notice from the Regional Director that the matter has been settled and the parties jointly request dismissal with prejudice.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
