The Gila River Indian Community (Community) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a Dismissal of Conditional Offer and Order Denying Rehearing entered on June 17, 2009, by Indian Probate Judge Melanie Daniel (IPJ) in the estate of Louann Stanley (Decedent), deceased Pima Maricopa (Salt River) Indian, Probate No. P000070109IP. The IPJ determined to be untimely the Community's conditional offer to purchase certain trust interests on the Gila River Reservation from Decedent's estate. *See* 25 U.S.C. § 2206(o).

On December 4, 2009, the Board received from the Community a motion to dismiss its appeal with prejudice.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
