The Gila River Indian Community (Community) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an Order Dismissing Conditional Offer and Denying Rehearing entered on June 16, 2009, by Indian Probate Judge Melanie Daniel (IPJ) in the estate of Vernita A. Antone, a.k.a. Vernita Ramone, a.k.a. Vernita Anne Anton, a.k.a. Vernita Anne Antone, a.k.a. Vernita Ann Antone (Decedent), deceased Pima Maricopa (Gila River) Indian, Probate No. P000045239IP. The IPJ determined to be untimely the Community's conditional offer to purchase certain trust interests in Decedent's estate. *See* 25 U.S.C. § 2206(o).

On December 4, 2009, the Board received from the Community a motion to dismiss its appeal with prejudice.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
