Rosemary Mattick and Edward Casey (Appellants) sought review from the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) of an October 13, 2009, decision of the Northwest Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), that modified the decision of the Superintendent, Puget Sound Agency, BIA, to adjust the rent for Lease No. 123 2086360328 HS, covering Lot 17, Block 1, of the Hermosa Point Summer Homesites on the Tulalip Reservation.

On March 24, 2010, the Board received a Joint Request for Dismissal of Appeal, Order of Vacation, and Remand from the parties. The Regional Director intends to reconsider Appellants' appeal from the Superintendent's decision, and issue a new decision.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Regional Director's October 13, 2009, decision is vacated, this matter is remanded to him for further consideration and issuance of a new decision, and Appellants' appeal is dismissed.
