Manny C. Iron Hawk (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an Order Denying Rehearing entered on March 31, 2010, by Indian Probate Judge Michael Stancampiano (IPJ) in the estate of Appellant’s mother, Goldie Nora Iron Hawk, a.k.a. Goldie War Bonnet (Decedent), deceased Cheyenne River Sioux Indian, Probate No. P000072437IP. Appellant contended that the IPJ erred in declining to give effect to a purported will executed by Decedent. The Board docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.

Appellant filed his notice of appeal without certifying or otherwise indicating that he had served a copy of his notice of appeal on all interested parties, as required by 43 C.F.R. §§ 4.310(b) and 4.320(c). On April 16, 2010, the Board ordered Appellant to complete these service requirements on or before May 3, 2010, and by that same date to file a statement with the Board that he had done so. The Board advised Appellant that if he did not comply with the order, “his appeal may be dismissed without further notice.” Pre-Docketing Notice and Order Concerning Service, Apr. 16, 2010, at 2 (emphasis omitted).

The Board has received no response from Appellant.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed this appeal but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.
