Wyoming Sawmills, Inc., appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a November 25, 2009, decision of the Acting Rocky Mountain Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA). The Regional Director upheld a decision by the Crow Agency Superintendent assessing damages against Appellant for breach of contract for timber sale Contract No. 14-20-OC52-0501, for the Upper Cookstove Logging Unit of the Crow Indian Reservation. The contract identifies the sellers as the present owners of allotments 1378, 1303-B, 1571-A, 1574, and 3407.

On June 1, 2010, the Board received a Joint Stipulation for Dismissal from the Regional Director and Appellant, stating that the parties have reached a settlement and requesting that the Board dismiss the appeal with prejudice. The Board appreciates the parties' successful efforts in resolving this dispute.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
