On April 12, 2010, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received from the Acting Great Plains Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs, a notice of appeal he had received from Trudy Chase Walsh (Appellant). The notice of appeal seeks review of a February 9, 2010, decision of the Regional Director, which upheld a decision by the Fort Berthold Agency Superintendent to award an agricultural lease containing Fort Berthold Allotments 963A and 970A to an operator other than Appellant. The notice of appeal was received by the Board after the 30-day deadline for filing an appeal had expired. *See* 43 C.F.R. § 4.332(a).

On April 21, 2010, the Board ordered Appellant to show cause, on or before May 14, 2010, why this appeal should not be dismissed as untimely.

The Board has received no response from Appellant.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed this appeal but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.
