Michael and Wendy Chevalier (Appellants) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a December 9, 2010, decision of the Acting Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), that affirmed a rent adjustment notice issued by the Superintendent of BIA’s Puget Sound Agency for Appellants’ Lease No. 122 2070490025 covering Lot 8, Division I, of the Doctor Joe Waterfront Tracts on the Swinomish Reservation in Washington.

On July 18, 2011, the Board received a “Joint Notice of Settlement and Request for Dismissal” from the parties in which the parties advise that the appeal has been settled and the Superintendent has approved an amended lease for Appellants. Therefore, the parties request that the Board dismiss this appeal from its docket. The Board appreciates the parties’ successful efforts in resolving this dispute.
