David Cavanaugh (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a February 28, 2011, decision of the Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), that affirmed, as modified, a June 23, 2008, decision by the Superintendent of BIA's Puget Sound Agency to increase the annual rental on Lease No. 122 2085469924 for Lot 4, Division I, of the Doctor Joe Waterfront Tracts on the Swinomish Reservation.

On November 18, 2011, the Board received a "Joint Notice of Settlement and Request for Dismissal" from the parties that advises that a settlement of this appeal has been finalized.
