Feeny (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a September 30, 2011, decision of the Acting Northwest Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), in which the Regional Director affirmed a decision by the Superintendent of BIA’s Puget Sound Agency to adjust the annual rent on Appellant’s Lease Number 123 2076250126 HS, covering Lot 87, Block 1, of the Hermosa Point Summer Homesites on the Tulalip Reservation in Washington.
