On November 7, 1980, an appeal from an order denying a petition for rehearing was docketed by the Board on behalf of Tom Giomi, Richard Giomi, Christine Joe Tom, and Roger G. Sam. A briefing schedule was established for the appeal. The briefing times expired without the filing of briefs by any party to the appeal.

On January 30, 1981, a "Stipulated Compromise" between Inez Sam Alvarado, the appellee, and Tom Giomi was submitted by counsel for these two parties. The compromise agreed to a dismissal of the appeal by Tom Giomi, but specifically stated that Tom Giomi did not represent the other three appellants.

The Board issued an order on February 3, 1981, giving Richard Giomi, Christine Joe Tom, and Roger G. Sam, 15 days from receipt of the order to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed. The Board stated that if no appearances were made by any of the interested parties, it would consider the appeal withdrawn. Return receipt cards indicate that the order was received by each of the three remaining appellants. No response has been received from any party.

Therefore, this appeal is dismissed in accordance with the Board's order of February 3, 1981.
