On May 16, 1989, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a notice of appeal from appellant Joseph (Jose) Moya. Appellant sought review of a decision of the Sacramento Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, denying him a certificate of eligibility to receive a public domain allotment under the General Allotment Act, 25 U.S.C. §§ 334, 336 (1982).

Pursuant to a request from appellant, the Board's consideration of this appeal was stayed pending settlement negotiations between the parties. The negotiations proved unsuccessful. Appellant's opening brief was due on or before December 6, 1989. The Board did not receive a brief.

On January 8, 1990, the Board received appellant's notice of withdrawal of appeal, dated December 4, 1989.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal from the decision of the Sacramento Area Director is dismissed.
