Appellant Terry H. Tate, d.b.a. Tate's Auto Center, sought review of an October 26, 1990, decision of the Acting Navajo Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning an order to cease and desist all selling activities within the exterior boundaries of the Navajo Indian Reservation. On December 17, 1990, the Board of Indian Appeals received a letter from appellant in which he withdrew his appeal.
