On April 30, 1991, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a letter from appellant Seraphin Cherrapkin, apparently in response to the Board's April 17, 1991, order docketing and dismissing her appeal in the above estate. 19 IBIA 294. The Board will treat the letter as a request for reconsideration.

Reconsideration of Board decisions is governed by 43 CFR 4.315, which provides that reconsideration will be granted only in extraordinary circumstances. Appellant's letter presents a detailed family history. This information, however, is not relevant to the basis for the Board's April 17 order, which determined that appellant lacked standing to contest the distribution determination made in Administrative Law Judge Keith L. Burrowes' February 15, 1991, order nunc pro tunc. The family history presented by appellant does not relate to or change that determination.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1 and 4.315, this request for reconsideration is denied.
